


## Puarenga Stream Scavenger Hunt

To begin this hunt, head south on SHW 5 towards Taupo and take a left at Waipa Mill Road (entry to Mountain biking hub at Whakarewarewa). Drive along Waipa State Mill Road then turn right onto Waipa Bypass Road, Head past Planet Bike and merge onto Eight Mile Road. You will see a white gate (eight mile Rd gate) that you can park near. Once parked walk towards the sign and you will hear the stream. Take a left at Larch Road.

This scavenger Hunt can be completed on foot or by bike so please be mindful that this is a dual use and two-way trail. Prams not advised, mountain buggies should be suitable (take at your own risk). Closest toilets are back at the Mountain Bike Hub. Allow 60 minutes to complete
