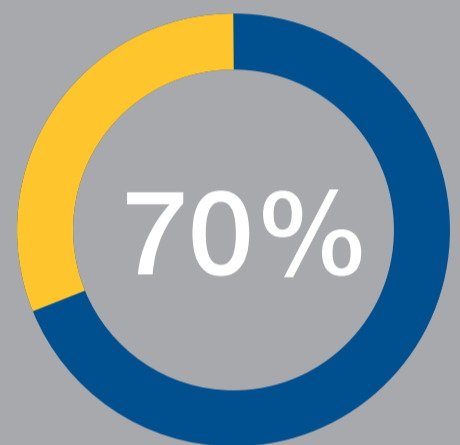
Leadership

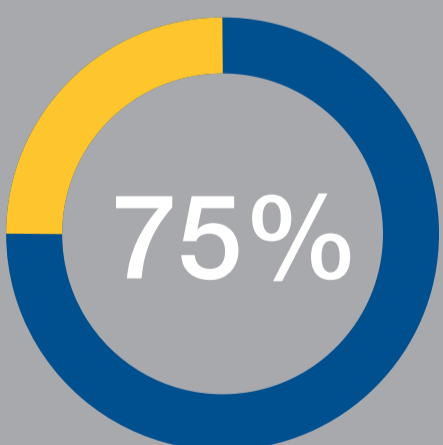

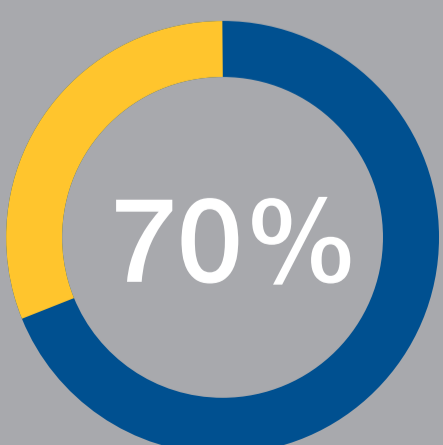
Collaboration

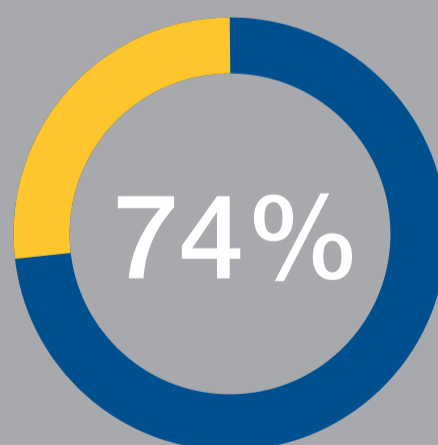

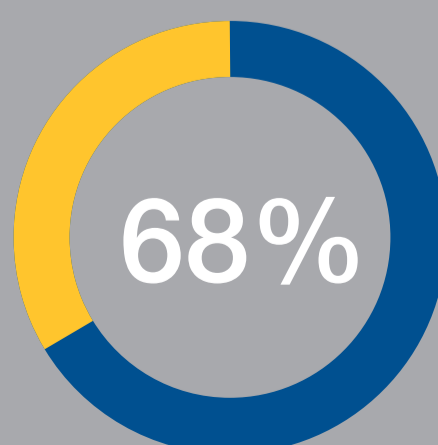
Communication
